It is recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) as a programmatic accrediting organization. It is also a member of the International Network for Quality Assurance Agencies in Higher Education - (INQAAHE).

The IACBE accredits business, accounting, and business-related degree programs at the associate, bachelor's, master's, and doctoral levels in institutions of higher education worldwide. It is based in Olathe, Kansas, United States, with member institutions in more than 20 countries throughout the world. Programmatic accreditation by the International Accreditation Council for Business Education is mission-driven and outcomes-based, and involves an independent, external evaluation of the business programs offered by an institution's academic business unit. The effectiveness of the academic business unit is evaluated by reviewing the educational processes related to teaching and learning in the institution, and by an assessment of the outcomes of the teaching-learning process.
